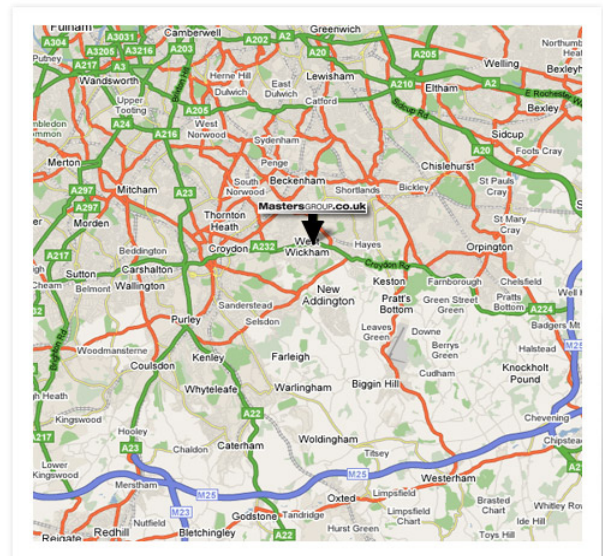




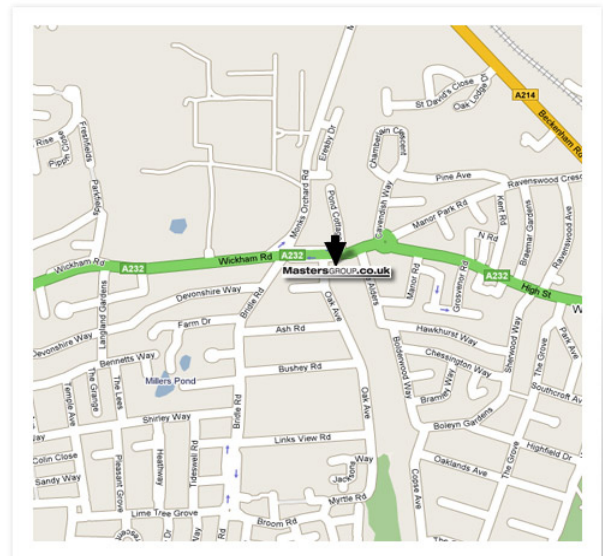
From the South Junction 6 (Godstone/M25)

- Take the A22 towards Caterham and Croydon. Follow the dual carriageway for 2 miles to a large concrete roundabout (Wapses Lodge).
- Take the 4th Exit and climb a steep windie narrow road for a quarter mile, at the T junction turn right.
- Follow the road for a mile until you reach Warlingham Green. Enter the roundabout and take the first Exit onto the B269 towards Sanderstead and Croydon.
- Continue on this road for 3 miles until you reach the roundabout with the junction of the A2022. Take the third Exit towards Selsdon.
- Continue on this road for another 4 miles following the A2022. The road takes you through Selsdon high street and brings you to the first of two roundabouts. Take the second exit at both going straight on towards Bromley.
- After a long straight road, the mad mile, (great place to try out a Renault Sport 225) the road brings you to a small roundabout next to a playing field. Take the first exit left and follow the road up a winding road to the traffic lights at West Wickham.
- Turn left at the lights and follow the road to the roundabout at the end of the high street. Take the first exit and Masters of Shirley is directly on the left.



From the North and West Junction 4 (Orpington M25)

- Exit at Junction 4 onto the A21 towards Orpington and Bromley. The road is about 4 miles and takes you over 4 or 5 roundabouts until you reach Farnborough traffic lights with Chapter One Restaurant on your left.
- The road forks left after the lights onto the A232. Follow the road for approx 3 miles past two sets of traffic lights and eventually the road narrows and goes downhill into Coney Hall with shops both sides of the road. At the roundabout take the second exit straight on. Now going up hill for ½ mile to a set of traffic lights at West Wickham.
- Go straight over the lights at West Wicham and follow the road to the roundabout at the end of the high street. Take the first exit and Masters of Shirley is directly on the left



Nearest main line train stations:

East Croydon (10 minute Taxi ride) which is 20 minutes from London Bridge or Victoria.



Nearest Tram stop:

East Croydon (Taxi's always available)
